This special session of the Mills County Commissioners Court opened in due form of law at 1:00 pm in the Mills County Commissioners' Courtroom located at 1011 4th Street, Goldthwaite, Texas

Present in the Courtroom: Judge Jett Johnson, Commissioners Head, Partin, Williams and Wright, County Deputy Clerk - Shawnee Martinez.
