## Mills County Commissioners Court Minutes January 4, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.

This Special Session of the Mills County Commissioners Court opened in due form of law at 9:00 am at the Mills County Law Enforcement Center, Goldthwaite, Texas 76844.

Present in the Courtroom: Judge Jett Johnson, Commissioners Partin, Head, Wright, and Williams. Please see sign in sheet for audience attendees.

The Opening Pledge of Allegiance and Pledge to the Texas Flag were led by Judge Johnson. Commissioner Williams provided the prayer.

There was no audience with individuals.

Court recessed at 9:03am to walk outside and observe the drainage issues at hand.

Court reconvened at 9:26am. Consider and act on purchasing drainage pipe from S&S Supply. There was a discussion on pipe vs rock pros and cons.

Commissioner Wright made the motion to put sandstone rock that would be donated in the drainage ditch on the west side of the LEC. Motion died for lack of a 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Commissioner Partin made the motion to use pipe purchased from S&S Supply in the drainage ditch, since it is the more permanent fix and was already in the budget for the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Head 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 4-1 with Commissioner Wright opposing.

Consider and act on repair of wash and entrance to impound yard. There was discussion on ways to slow down and or divert the runoff. It seems that the best option to start with is to put a curb around the landscaping next to Old Priddy Rd. It was also discussed to build a retainer wall.

Commissioner Williams made a motion to use county funds to pay for the curb to go along Old Priddy Rd. and pay for cement blocks to deter water with a maximum of 15,000 being spent from non-departmental funds. Commissioner Partin provided the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Carried 5-0

Commissioner Wright made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Head 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Carried 5-0
