





Priddy: Project Information To Date

- Priddy can potentially support up to a 300.24 MW project.
- 104 parcels signed with over 33,000 acres under wind easement.
- On-site meteorological towers have been monitoring the wind resource.
- Ongoing environmental work including biological surveys, cultural, acoustic, shadow flicker, and wetlands. Efforts to advance engineering design also in

process.

Priddy: Project Information To Date

- Title review to ensure accurate boundaries and clear any encumbrances.
- Interconnection agreement that would allow the Project to tie-into the grid has been executed by Oncor, ERCOT, and ENGIE.
- Significant offtake opportunity expected shortly.
- Turbine selection almost complete.

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Priddy: Schedule

Construction is slated to begin in March 2021

- Transmission Line Site Preparation, Foundations
- Road Improvements
- Grading and Foundations, Turbines & Substation

Construction of Facilities:

- Turbines Constructed through October 2021
- Collection System through September 2021
- Transmission Line through August 2021
- Substation Constructed by October 2021


Testing and Commissioning, Sep-Oct 2021

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Project Benefits

- \$312MM capital investment
- Construction
 - 250 construction employees
- Operations
 - 8 permanent jobs (ENGIE and turbine supplier)
 - Comprised of both supervisory and technician positions
 - Requires people to live w/in 1 hour of the County
 - Total annual payroll: \$464,000 + benefits
 - Estimated wage average of \$58,000
- Additional Benefits (aside from 312 and 313 abatement agreements)
 - Once project is in operations, an additional \$25,000 per year has been allocated to support various community needs for the life of the project







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
