



Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) **FREE Tax Preparation!**

To qualify:

Household income of \$55,000 a year or less.

Must bring the following documents:

- Photo ID
- Social Security card or ITIN card (for you, your spouse, and all dependents)
- W-2s
- 1095-(A, B, or C) (proof of health insurance)

If applicable:

- Copy of last year's Federal Tax return
- 1099-G (unemployment insurance benefits)
- 1099-INT (bank interest)
- 1098-T (gambling winnings)
- 1098-E (interest on a student loan)
- Notice 1319 (advance child credit)
- 1099-MISC
- Void check/savings account statement with bank routing numbers (optional)
- If you are married filing jointly, your spouse needs to be present at the appointment

IRS certified VITA volunteers provide basic income tax return services without charge, ensuring 100% of your tax refund goes directly to YOU!

- Married Filing Separately
- Schedule C with loss, depreciation, or business use of home
- Complicated Schedule D (capital gains and losses)
- Form SS-5 (request for Social Security Number)
- Form 8606 (non-deductible IRA)
- Form 8615 (child taxed at parent's tax rate)
- Form SS-8 (determination of worker status for purposes of federal employment taxes and income tax withholding)
- Parts 4 & 5 of Form 8962 (premium tax credits)
